

## UNIFORM FAQ

Q: Can my 4<sup>th</sup> grade daughter wear navy blue skirts?

A: No. K-5 girls must wear plaid jumpers, plaid skirts, or navy blue uniform pants

Q: Can my daughter wear her plaid skirt from St. Matthew's/St. John Vianney/Holy Trinity?

A: Yes. Girls may wear their previous school's plaid during the 2012-2013 school year; however, going forward, the new plaid must be worn.

Q: Where can I purchase the new plaid skirts and jumpers?

A: You may visit the Donald's uniform website. The plaid number is #59. The website address is <http://www.donaldsuniform.com>.

Q: Does my child have to wear dress shoes in class and tennis shoes for recess or gym?

A: No. Your child may wear tennis shoes throughout the day. Two pairs of shoes are not required. Please make sure the tennis shoes are in good condition. Avoid loud colors that may be considered disruptive/distracting.

Q: Can navy blue leggings or dark blue skinny jeans be worn instead of navy blue uniform pants?

A: No. Children may only wear navy blue uniform pants. No jeans, "skinny" cut pants, spandex, or leggings may be worn as uniform pants. Please make sure that the uniform pants are the appropriate length and fit.

Q: Weather permitting, can children wear navy uniform shorts in the fall and spring?

A: Yes.

Q: Where may I purchase the optional grey logo or ¾ zipper navy blue fleece logo sweatshirts?

A: You may purchase them from Sportlettering2. The original bulk order was due to the office at the beginning of August. Those who ordered by that time can pick up their order the evening of the Open

House. Additional orders will be collected and sent in throughout the year and checks need to be made out to Community of Saints. Parents will be updated regarding when to expect the next order deadline. Individual orders will not be accepted by Sportlettering2. All individual orders must go through the school office and will be combined for one bulk order.

Q: Does my son have to wear a tie to school?

A: 6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade boys and girls may wear the optional navy blue tie, which may be purchased through Donald's; however, the tie is not a requirement of the uniform. If worn, it may only be worn with a white oxford shirt.

Q: Can my 8<sup>th</sup> grade daughter wear a plaid jumper?

A: The appropriate uniform for the 6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade girls is the navy blue uniform skirt or navy blue uniform pants with white polo or oxford, or the light blue oxford. However, during the 2012-2013 school year, girls may wear the plaid from their previous school. Going forward into the 2013-2014 school year, only navy blue will be allowed.

Q: Can my child wear the red polos from last year?

A: No. The only color polo shirts that are allowed are white. Red, yellow, grey, light blue, navy blue, or royal blue polo shirts are not allowed. White polo shirts with Teflon coating can be purchased through Sportlettering2. Otherwise, any white polo shirt from Target, Wal-Mart, Lands End, Herberger's, etc. is acceptable.

Q: Can my daughter wear a light blue Peter Pan collar shirt under her jumper?

A: No. Only WHITE Peter Pan collar shirts are to be worn under the jumpers.

Q: Can my daughter wear her Peter Pan collar shirt with her navy blue uniform pants or plaid skirt?

A: No. The Peter Pan collar shirts can only be worn UNDER the jumpers. Skirts should be worn with oxfords or polos.
